# Logistical Information & useful links

#### **Ensenada location & climate**

Ensenada is on the northwestern, Pacific coast of Mexico, in the state of Baja California. Ensenada is just 110 km south of the US border at Tijuana, and 135 km (84 miles) south of central San Diego in California. It is over 2825 km from Mexico City – at least 36 hours by road and 3 hours by plane.

Ensenada has a mild, Mediterranean-like climate – it stays relatively dry year-round (though it's slighter wetter in the winter than the summer) and experiences surprisingly cool weather from December to March. The average temperature in January ranges from a high of 18°C to a low of 9°C (bring a jacket).

#### **Currency**

Although the Mexican peso is the official currency in Ensenada (often prefixed with a "\$" sign), many hotels, restaurants, and vendors will accept US. However, change will often be given in pesos, and US dollar prices invariably work out to be higher than peso prices because of inflated exchange rates.

Try to use ATMs to withdraw peso cash in Ensenada if possible. Credit cards are widely accepted, but cash is needed for buses, most taxis, and small purchases.

#### **Airports:**

The hosts will arrange pick-up by minibus/car from the two main arrival airports (see below), to bring delegates to Ensenada. They will also take delegates to their departure airport after the conference. The

aim will be to provide one or two time slots per airport each day, depending on the timings of delegates' flights.

The nearest major airport is at **Tijuana** (a 1 hour 45 minute drive from Downtown Ensenada). Many international flights will route to Tijuana via Mexico City.

**San Diego** airport in the USA is also a nearby option (geographically, the airport is approx. 2 hours by road). Therefore, transportation from San Diego to Ensenada will not be a problem when arriving. However, for the return, delegates should allow 2 hours to cross the border into the US, plus the minimum of 2 hours recommended before international departure. Please also be aware that Terminal 1 is being remodelled, so expect to find long queues at airport security.

#### **Local transport**

Buses run from Tijuana airport direct to Ensenada; taxis can also be taken, but these are expensive (at least US\$80), though a lot more convenient. Buses also run between the US border at Tijuana and Ensenada bus station every hour or so and take around 1 hour 30 minutes.

Within Ensenada, transport options include local buses, taxis and Uber.

#### Information about Visas to enter Mexico:

Depending on your route of entry to Mexico, you may need visas for both Mexico and the USA. Please check requirements carefully.
